How is one supposed to decide between Bible-affirming presuppositionalism and Qur'an-affirming presuppositionalism?

- 1) The absurdity of the contrary. If you deny the authenticity of the bible (Torah and Injil) as Muslims do you must deny Islam, because Allah has inspired the Torah, but has allowed the Injil to be corrupted.
- 2) We cannot start with the presupposition that Allah exists either. The Islamic Doctrine of "Tanzih" (Transcendence) - Surah 42:11 renders Allah (unknowable) in a linguistical sense meaning we cannot have a Revelatory Epistemology in Islam, which means we cannot know whether Allah has in fact revealed himself in the words of the Quran.
