

Arminianism – Jesus' Blood

John 6:52-56 NASB

Then the Jews began to argue with one another, saying, "How can this man give us His flesh to eat?" [53] So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves. [54] He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. [55] For My flesh is true food, and My blood is true drink. [56] He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him.

Acts 20:28 NASB

Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Romans 5:9 NASB

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

1 Corinthians 10:16 NASB

Is not the cup of blessing which we bless a sharing in the blood of Christ? Is not the bread which break a sharing in the body of Christ?

Ephesians 1:7 NASB

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

Ephesians 2:13 NASB

But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

Hebrews 9:14 NASB

how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 13:12 NASB

Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood suffered outside the gate.

1 Peter 1:18-19 NASB

knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, [19] but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

1 John 1:7 NASB

but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Revelation 1:5-6 NASB

and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves us and released us from our sins by His blood [6] and He has made us to be a kingdom, priests to His God and Father-to Him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

What does the blood do?

■ Jesus' blood is for the forgiveness of sins:

Matthew 26:28 NASB

for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

Ephesians 1:7 NASB

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

Hebrews 9:22 NASB

And according to the Law, one may almost say, all things are cleansed with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

■ Jesus' blood purchased the Church:

Acts 20:28 NASB

Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

■ Jesus' blood justifies the Church:

Romans 5:9 NASB

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

■ Jesus' blood redeems us as saints:

Ephesians 1:7 NASB

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

■ Jesus' blood brings us near to the commonwealth and promises of Israel:

Ephesians 2:13 NASB

But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

■ Jesus' blood cleanses us:

Hebrews 9:14 NASB

how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

■ Jesus' blood sanctifies:

Hebrews 13:12 NASB

Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

Faith » Justification

Propitiation » Appeasement of Wrath

Expiation » Cancellation or Cleansing of Sin

By his blood we are purchased, and cleaned of our sin canceling the debt penalty. By faith in his blood or sufferings we are made clean.
